- Complete Criminal Background check if it's out of date (Expires after 5 years). To Complete background check go to https://epatch.state.pa.us and click New Volunteer Application.
- If you have NOT been a resident of PA for longer than 10 years, you will need to complete an FBI fingerprint background check. Go to www.pa.cogentid.com.
 - Select Dept of Education.
 - Under registration information, select Register Online. Once registered, go to
 Print Site locations to find nearest location.
 - CVCCS only needs the unofficial copy of your prints. Bring in receipt for reimbursement by CVCCS.
- Fill out Emergency Contact Form. Please bring this with you to Mentor Orientation.
