In April 2019, a group of Lancaster County community leaders came together and developed an inventory of existing community resources for people with **special transportation needs**, identified the most pressing gaps in our county transportation system, and recommended short-term and long-term solutions. The group defined people with special transportation needs as people who are unable to transport themselves or to purchase transportation because of physical or mental disability, income status, or age.
