

Back on Track

We know that unforeseen circumstances can create financial difficulties. Our goal is to provide one-time relief for an immediate need to prevent individuals/families from getting derailed financially. Along with any financial assistance, we will provide financial counseling to encourage and build financial stability. Back on Track is a limited funds program.

This fund is available to working individuals/families residing in the Conestoga Valley School District who have a stable housing situation. Clients must be gainfully employed to qualify. Needs may include things such as car repairs, rental and utility assistance, and medication costs.

Participants must:

- provide their financial information**
- read and agree to the policies**
- commit to meet with financial counselors for 1 intake session and 2 follow-up sessions which will include:**

- 1. assessing immediate need and available resources**
- 2. reviewing financial situation, developing a budget**
- 3. action steps for moving forward (Ongoing counseling will be available if desired)**

A committee will decide upon any request for assistance. Assistance is not a loan and does not need to be repaid. Payments will be paid directly to the service provider. Payments may be in the form of a match and will be limited by funds available.
