Program highlight: Clothing Bank

This month's program highlight is the Clothing Bank at CVCCS. While we can't take credit for its creation, we have continued to serve clients from all parts of Lancaster County.

This is how it works:

To access the clothing bank, clients will need a referral every two years. This can come from a social service agency that they are working with, the school social worker, or a church. Once that is received, clients can call us at 717-208-3711, ext. 100, to make an appointment.

Clients are able to browse our racks just like they would in a department store. We have a selection of new and gently used clothing, shoes, and accessories. We change our inventory 2 times a year, Spring and Fall, to allow clients to get winter and summer clothing. Our personal shoppers are available to help clients as much or as little as they need while shopping.

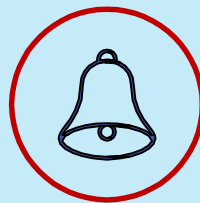


Bible2School Recap
