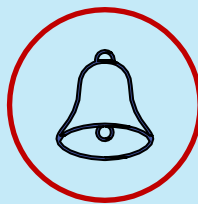
Bible2School Update

CVCCS is excited to expand its Bible2School program by partnering with Leola Elementary School, providing students with the opportunity to participate in off-campus, Bible-based character education during the school day in accordance with Pennsylvania's released-time religious instruction law. This expansion reflects CVCCS's ongoing commitment to serving children and families throughout the Conestoga Valley community by helping students develop a strong moral foundation, biblical knowledge, and positive character traits such as kindness, respect, responsibility, and compassion. By adding Leola Elementary to the program, CVCCS will be able to reach more children with lessons that encourage faith, hope, and integrity while continuing to work collaboratively with families, volunteers, and the school community to ensure a safe, meaningful, and enriching experience for participating students.

Program Highlight: Weekend Blessings

CVCCS's Weekend Blessings Program helps address childhood hunger by providing nutritious, easy-to-prepare food to students who may not have reliable access to meals when school is not in session. Each week, participating children receive a discreet bag with 2 breakfast, lunch, dinner, and snack items to take home for the weekend. Working in partnership with CV schools ensures these children have food available during the days they are away from school, helping to reduce food insecurity while improving their ability to return to the classroom on Monday healthy, nourished, and ready to learn.
